This is a Capital Improvement Project. The work specified in this project will require the Contractor to provide all labor and materials to perform the following work:

The Contractor must excavate and expose existing pipe starting from edge of concrete landing. The excavated area is to be 12' long x 5' wide x 4' deep. The Contractor must take caution not to damage the bulkhead tie back located approximately 12" north of pipe and 9' west of the head wall. The Contractor must remove a 4' section of existing 15" x 4' concrete pipe that has broken and moved out of alignment. They must provide and install one (1) 15" rcp pipe, including saw cuts, to modify the pipe by removing bell end and cutting it to length to fit between the two existing 15" concrete pipe, forming two butt joints at each end. The work shall also include removing any concrete placed under pipe from previous repairs. The Contractor must provide and install two (2) Mar Mac Polyseal pipe couplers or approved equivalent at each butt joint. The installation must be performed per manufacturer's instructions. The Contractor shall install a mortar bed under the butt joints using sack cement to help support pipe; backfill and compact excavated hole; and remove and reinstall 7' of existing wood fence and gate in order to gain access. They must remove and reinstall a 7'2" x 2' x 4" concrete landing. The concrete shall be 3000 psi, class M concrete as specified in the LADOTD Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges Section 706, 2016 Edition. The Contractor must provide and install sod to all disturbed areas and remove all debris at no direct pay. The Contractor shall verify all dimensions.

The time period for completion of the project is thirty (30) calendar days from Notice to Proceed issued by the Parish.

A Quote Guarantee **is not** required for this project.

Any work that may be reasonably inferred from the specifications or drawings as being required to produce the intended result shall be supplied whether or not it is specifically called for. Work, materials or equipment described herein which so applied to this project are covered by a well-known technical meaning or specification shall be deemed to be governed by such recognized standards unless specifically excluded.
