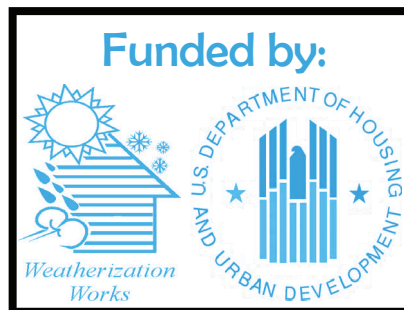
Delivering energy efficiency services to low-income households.

What is Repairs on Wheels?

- Repairs on Wheels is a partnership between St. Tammany Parish Government and Volunteers of America, Greater New Orleans.
- Repairs on Wheels leverages Weatherization and CDBG funding to weatherize homes of low-income residents in St. Tammany Parish to increase energy efficiency and reduce energy use; therefore reducing the client's energy bills.
- Repairs on Wheels utilizes volunteer labor to assist in the weatherization of homes. This allows Repairs on Wheels to serve the maximum number of clients without increasing labor costs.

What are examples of weatherization?

- Install Insulation
- Tune-ups & repairs to heating and cooling systems
- Weather stripping
- Install solar screens
- Install vented space heaters
- Install smoke & CO2 detectors



Who qualifies for services?

- Residents meeting the program definition of “low-income” qualify for a home assessment.
- An eligibility determination is made after the home assessment.
